Theoretical Orientation:

I practice Imago Relationship Therapy (IRT) which is a unique blend of Psychodynamic, Gestalt, and Cognitive/Behavioral Therapy. IRT sees the committed, intimate relationship as the best place to realize the deepest levels of growth and healing. IRT is the only form of therapy I choose to practice. As a psychotherapist, I desire to facilitate clients to find healing from childhood wounds, to eliminate debilitating symptoms, to realize personal potential and creative expression, and to experience wholeness and full aliveness.
